## Signposting patients to other services more appropriate for their care



Ainsdale Medical Centre has adopted a Signposting Service operated by our trained staff.

We have trained our staff to ask appropriate questions about your call so they can allocate you to the most suitable clinician or alternative service.

These staff members are NOT prying; they work under the GP's instructions and are bound by the same code of confidentiality as the clinical staff.

For example, if you have an eye problem, you may be signposted to an optician; if you have a mouth problem, you may be signposted to a dentist, or you may be signposted to a pharmacy.

There will be a Health and Well Being Event running alongside our flu clinics at the church on both days. Members of our Patient Participation Group will be there talking to our patients. Please take the opportunity to chat with them if there is anything you would like to say about our Surgery.

## Flu Clinic for 18 to 64 at Risk, Pregnant, Vulnerable

# BY APPOINTMENT ONLY

The Surgery has organised an appointment-only Flu clinic on:

Saturday, 7th October, between 9 am and 3 pm at

#### **Ainsdale Medical Centre**

This is only for patients aged between 18 and 64 who are pregnant, vulnerable/at-risk.

We will not vaccinate over 65's in this clinic as it is a different vaccine.

This will be by invitation only; all eligible patients will be contacted in late September.

#### Children's Flu Clinics - Dates to be arranged

Children aged 2 or 3 years on 31 August 2023 (born between 1 September 2019 and 31 August 2021) Children aged 2 to 17 years with certain long-term health conditions

If your child is aged between 6 months and 2 years and has a long-term health condition that makes them at higher risk from flu, they'll be offered a flu vaccine injection instead of the nasal spray.

This is because the nasal spray is not licensed for children under 2 years old.

The nasal spray vaccine offers the best protection for children aged 2 to 17 years. They'll be offered a flu vaccine injection if the nasal spray vaccine is not suitable for them. Injected flu vaccines are also safe and effective.

## **Activity in the Practice**




We offered **15,510** Clinician appointments between **May - July 2023**

# Did you know you can download the NHS APP and order repeat medication?

From mid-October 2023, we will be turning on prospective patient access. This will give you online access to lab results, documents, consultations, medication etc.

In the meantime, if you would like access, please get in touch with the Surgery and ask for these services to be activated. You will need to answer security questions, asked by the Receptionist, and it can take up to 6 weeks.

We are working on adding more appointment types for patients to book with Clinicians online. These can range from a Text message consultation, Telephone consultation, Face to Face consultation, and GP-initiated online booking appointment. Please be patient while we work on introducing these appointment types.
